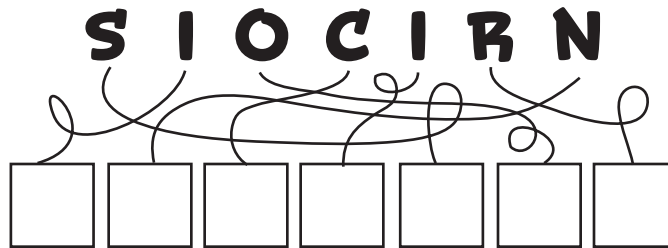

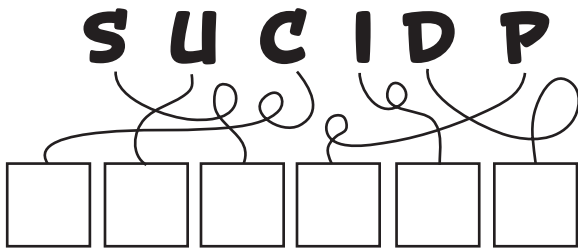
DID YOU KNOW ...

Help K-9 learn their names.

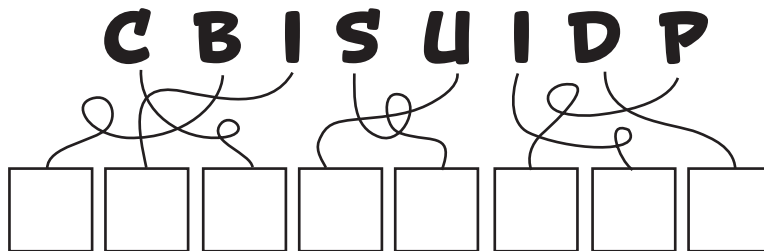
Unscramble the words by following the floss path and then write the letter in the box.



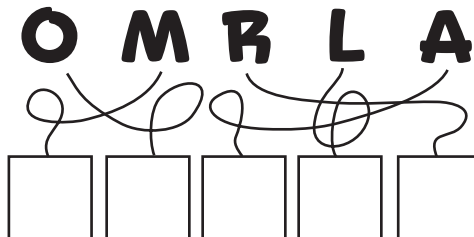
1. These flat front teeth are for biting into food.

4. These big teeth at the back of your mouth grind food into very small pieces.

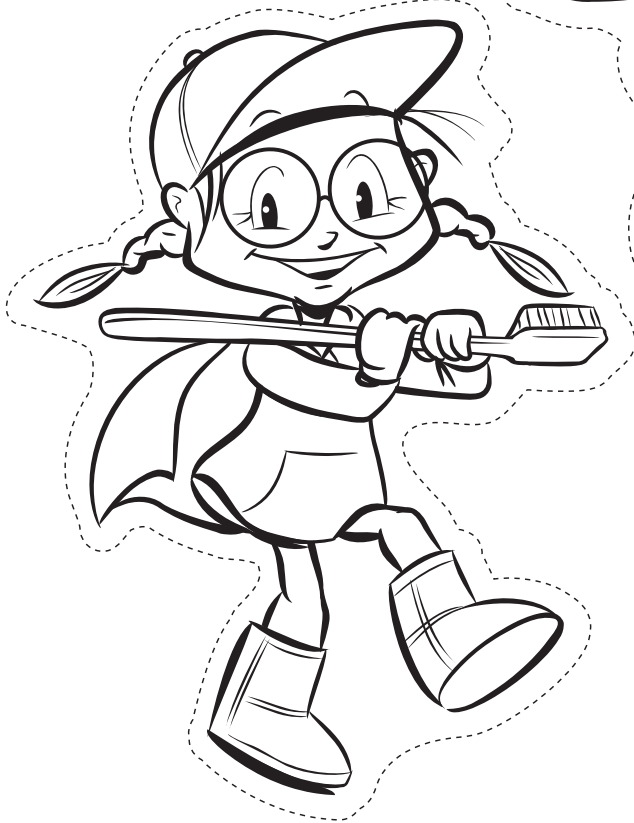
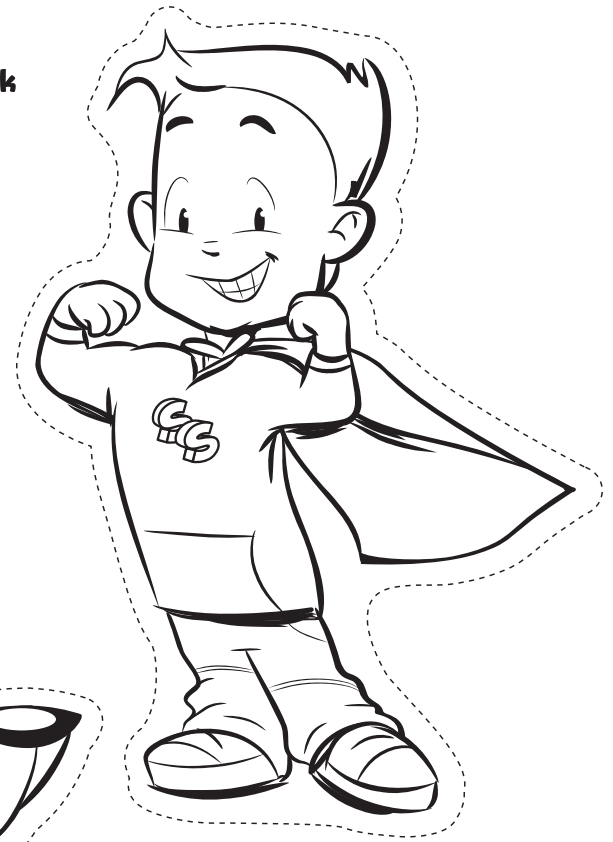


MAKE A SUPER SMILE PUPPET SHOW!

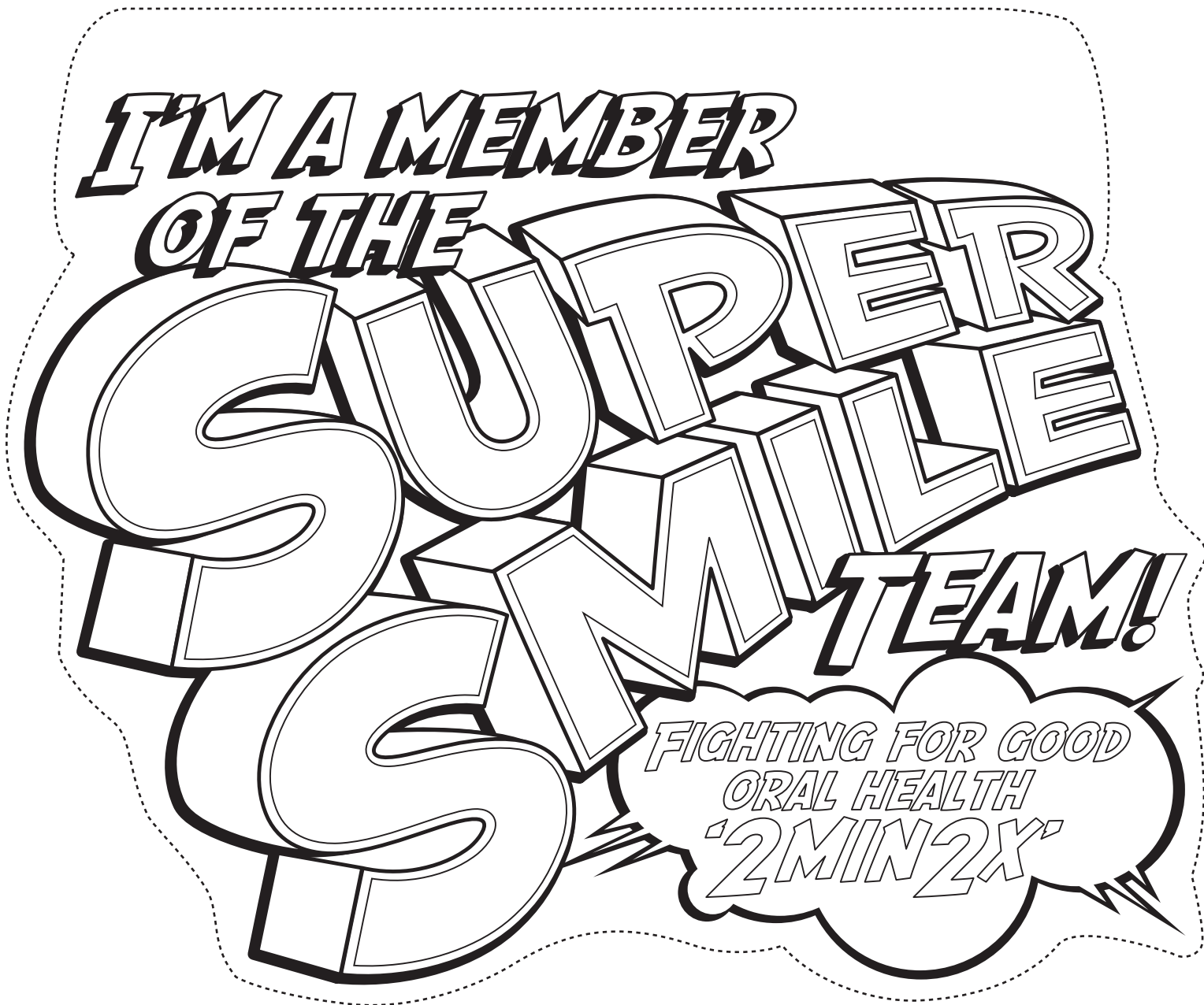


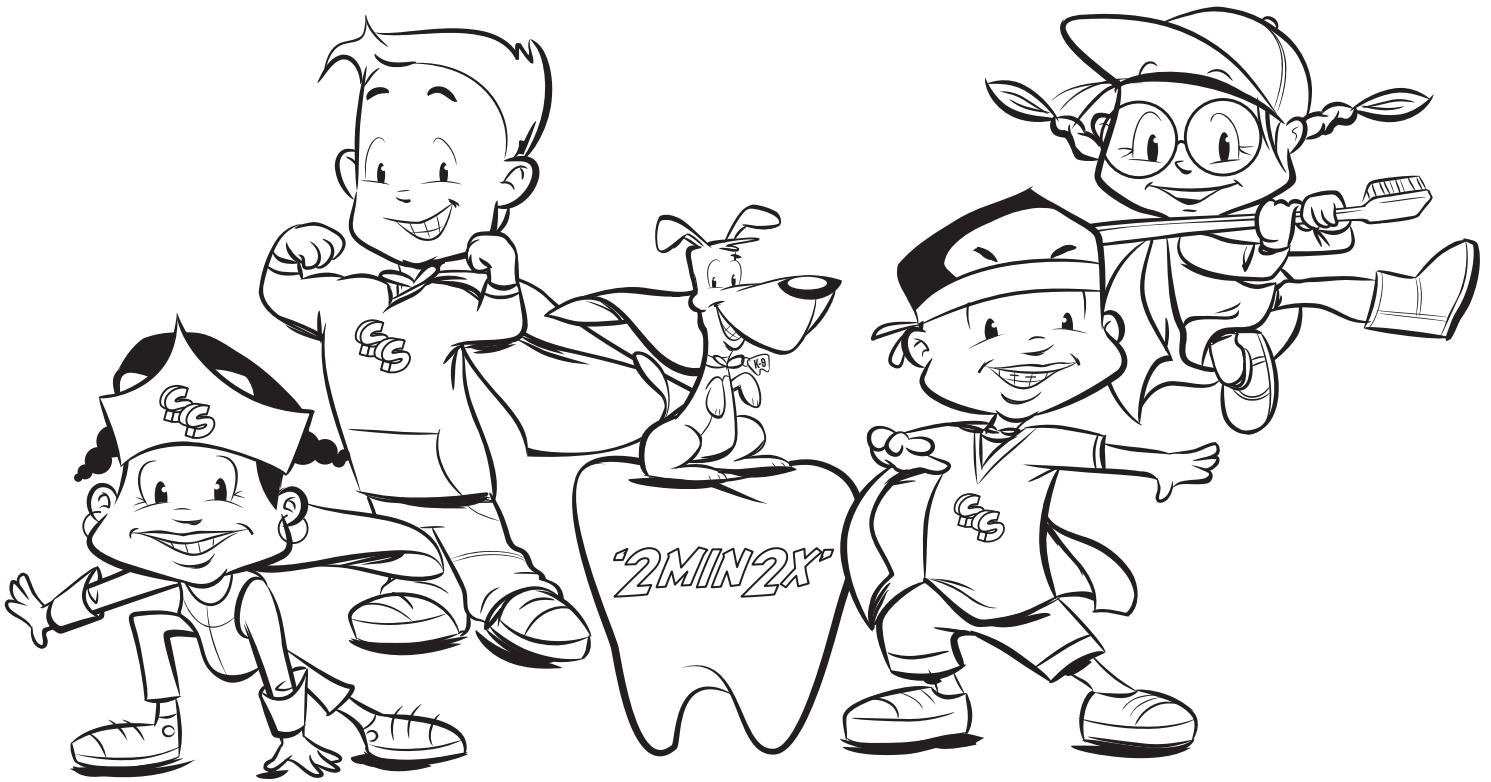
