### **CHAPTER XV • FINANCES**

1830 Section 10 F. MEMBERS ELECTED AFTER JULY 1. (lines added

1831 after line 1608) amended as follows:

1832 F. MEMBERS ELECTED AFTER JULY 1. All members except

1833 life, student and honorary members, elected after July 1,

1834 shall pay one-half of the current year's dues. A former active

1835 member of this Association upon being re-elected to active

1836 membership shall be required to pay the full year's dues.

The following amendments to the Bylaws of the American Dental Association were approved by the House of Delegates at the 1951 annual session.

#### CHAPTER II • CONSTITUENT SOCIETIES

1706 Section 40. Membership: (line 249) amended to read as follows: 1707 The fully privileged membership, except as otherwise pro-

1708 vided in these Bylaws, of each constituent society shall be

1709 limited to dentists practicing within the territorial jurisdic-

1710 tion of such constituent society or to dentists in a federal

1711 dental service, provided that such dentists are in good stand-

1712 ing in a component society thereof, if such exists, and pro-

1713 vided that they are active or life members in good standing

1714 of this Association.

1715 Section 90. PRIVILEGE OF REPRESENTATION: (line 291)

1717 PRIVILEGE OF REPRESENTATION: Each constituent society

1718 shall have the privilege of representation in the House of

1719 Delegates of this Association by one or more fully privileged

1720 members of such society who are selected to serve as official-

1722 (1) delegate for one (1) through ninety-nine (99) members

1723 classified as active or life members of this Association, one 1724 (1) additional delegate for the next two hundred (200) such

1725 members or fraction thereof; one (1) additional delegate for
