Dr. Bennett will be presented with this award at the President's Banquet on March 12 at English Turn Country Club. A 1985 graduate of the LSU School of Dentistry, Don is a past President of the New Orleans Dental Association and a past Chairman of the New Orleans Dental Conference LDA Annual Session.

When asked about his career path, Dr. Bennett related that he had decided on his career choice in the 8th grade. Don remembers that the father of two of his childhood friends was an orthodontist. Don became close to the family and they helped to influence him to a career

in dentistry. Dr. Bennett recalls his family moved quite a bit in his youth. Don has lived in Chicago, Los Angeles, San Francisco, Salt Lake City, Kansas City, and of course south Louisiana.

While in dental school. Dr. Bennett was a member of Psi Omega Dental Fraternity. Don was also admitted into the C. Edmond Dental Honor Society. Following graduation from dental school, Dr. Toso encouraged Don to NODA functions attend eventually to serve on the NODC Board as Registration Chairman. registration From Chair Scientific Chair, Don eventually rose to the position of General Chairman in 2013. As most leaders do, he began his leadership in the New Orleans Dental Association as an at-large member on the Board of Governors. His commitment and volunteerism in dentistry and his community befit a recipient of the

Honor Dentist award. He served as Board member, fundraising Chairman, and as President of the Children's Oncology Services of Louisiana (The Ronald McDonald House) from 1988-1992. He served as a Board Member, Treasurer, and Vice President of St Andrew the Apostle School Board. He is a past President of the Bienville Club. Don has volunteered as coach of 28 different boy's and girl's youth teams at Plantation Athletic Club. His professional accomplishments are also exemplary. In 2014 Don received the Louisiana Dental Association Star for outstanding service. Don was inducted as a Fellow in the American College of Dentists in 2015 and a Fellow in the International College of Dentists in 2016. These mentors helped Don realize that if you want to change things for the better you have to be involved. He said "By being involved, I learned from the best and brightest dentists in our area." Organized dentistry helped my leadership skills, yielded insightful guidance on running a dental office, and provided invaluable knowledge gained via the camaraderie of fellow dentists. Don states. "I cherish the friendships I have made and I continue to be amazed at the talent and work ethic that exists in NODA." In spite of the many headwinds dentistry is facing today, he still views the profession optimistically. He hopes that the solo practice model remains viable. Don enjoys being his own boss.

Dr. Bennett's message to the newest generation of dentists is to get and stay involved with organized dentistry because of the support and valuable resources that this provides. He also recommends to stay out of debt as much as possible. "It frees up your mind as well as time to do things you want to do." Colleagues in dentistry remain open to helping each other so that if you're having a problem with any aspect of dental practice, be it clinical or administrative, there's most likely someone else

who has effectively navigated the same challenge.

Finally, Dr. Bennett expressed his immense gratitude for being selected by his peers for NODA's most prestigious award and hopes to see as many of his friends as possible at the President's Banquet in March.




