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

AMENDMENTS

The following amendments to the Bylaws of the American Dental Association were approved by the House of Delegates at the 1956 annual session.

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CHAPTER I - MEMBERSHIP

Section 20D. Student Member. (lines 113-122) amended to read as follows:

D. Student Member. An undergraduate of a dental school accredited by this Association and any dentist with required membership qualifications who is engaged full time in advanced training courses of not less than one academic year's duration in accredited schools and hospitals, on the payment of dues as provided in Chapter XVI of these Bylaws, shall be classified as a student member of this Association. In order to become an active member, a student member shall comply with Chapter I, Section 20A of the Bylaws.

Section 40G. Professional Conduct. (lines 186-189) amended to read as follows:

G. Professional Conduct. The professional conduct of every member of this Association shall be governed by the Principles of Ethics of this Association and by the codes of ethics of the constituent and component society within whose jurisdiction he practices.

CHAPTER II - CONSTITUENT SOCIETIES

Section 40. Membership. (lines added after line 263) Section 10G, Chapter XVI to become Section 40B, Chapter II, to read as follows:

B. Removal from One Jurisdiction to Another. A member who has changed the location of his practice from the jurisdiction of one constituent society to that of another constituent society may, in order to remain in good standing in the Association, maintain his active membership in the constituent society of which he was a member for the calendar year following that of his removal from the jurisdiction of such society.

Section 110. Chartered Constituent Societies. (line 357) amended to read as follows:

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## CHAPTER V . HOUSE OF DELEGATES

Section 140Ba. Reference Committees. (lines 716-722) amended to read as follows:

a. Personnel. Reference committees, consisting of five officially certified delegates, shall be appointed by the President at least sixty (60) days in advance of each annual session of the House of Delegates, except that the Council on Constitution and Bylaws of this Association shall serve as the reference committee on Constitution and Bylaws of the House of Delegates.

## CHAPTER VI . BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Section 90. Duties. (lines 877-878) Subsection 0 deleted and the following subsections relettered.

## CHAPTER IX . COUNCILS

Section 20Ba(2). Council on Dental Education. (lines 1756-1761) amended to read as follows:

(2) Three (3) members shall be nominated by the American Association of Dental Examiners from the active membership of that body, no one of whom shall be a member of a faculty of a school of dentistry.

Section 20Ca(2). Council of the National Board of Dental Examiners. (lines 1765-1770) amended to read as follows:

(2) Three (3) members shall be nominated by the American Association of Dental Examiners from the active membership of that body, no one of whom shall be a member of a faculty of a school of dentistry.

Section 100H. Council on Federal Dental Services. (lines added after line 1286) amended by the addition of the following subsection c.

c. To formulate plans for the participation of dentists in civil defense programs and to submit such plans to the Board of Trustees for action in conformity with policies adopted by the House of Delegates.

Section 100I. Council on Hospital Dental Service. (lines 1302-1304) amended by the deletion of subsection b.

CHAPTER XVI . FINANCES

Section 10C. Student Members. (lines 1601-1608) amended to read as follows:

C. Student Members. The dues of student members shall be three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50) due January 1 of each year. Student membership terminates on December 31 after graduation and on completion of an internship, residency or graduate work as provided in Chapter I, Section 20D. Dues for the first calendar year after the termination of student membership shall be three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50) provided the student member is accepted for the first time as an active member of a constituent or component society.

Section 10G. Removal from One Jurisdiction to Another. (lines 1622-1629) amended by transferring this section to Chapter II, Section 40.
