Amendments

The following amendments to the *Bylaws* of the American Dental Association were approved by the House of Delegates at the 1959 annual session.

.....

CHAPTER I • MEMBERSHIP

Section 50A. DUES AND REINSTATEMENT (lines 190-191) amended to read:

1603 A. ACTIVE MEMBERS. The dues of active members shall be
1604 thirty dollars (\$30.00) due January 1 of each year.

CHAPTER II • CONSTITUENT SOCIETIES

Section 110. CHARTERED CONSTITUENT SOCIETIES (line 330) amended to read:

1605 Hawaii State Dental Association.

CHAPTER IV • TRUSTEE DISTRICTS

Section 30. COMPOSITION (line 461) amended to read:

1606 Hawaii State Dental Association.

CHAPTER VI • BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Section 70. VACANCY (lines 746-750) amended to read:

1607 *Section 70. VACANCY:* In the event of a vacancy in the
1608 office of trustee, the President shall appoint a voting mem-
1609 ber of the same constituent society, unless such privilege
1610 is yielded by that constituent society, to fill such office until
1611 a successor is elected by the next House of Delegates for the
1612 remainder of the unexpired term.

CHAPTER IX • COUNCILS

Section 110B. COUNCIL ON DENTAL EDUCATION (lines 1090-1093) amended to read:

1613 c. To approve on behalf of this Association internships
1614 and residencies in accordance with requirements and
1615 standards approved by the House of Delegates.

Section 110B further amended by the addition of the following as subsection d:

1616 d. To study and make recommendations on (1) the recog-
1617 nition of special areas of dental practice; (2) the approval
1618 or disapproval of national certifying boards for special
1619 areas of dental practice; (3) the educational and adminis-
1620 trative standards of the certifying boards; and to act on
1621 behalf of this Association in maintaining effective liaison
1622 with the certifying boards and related special groups.

Section 110H. COUNCIL ON HOSPITAL DENTAL SERVICE (lines 1143-1151) amended to read:

1623 H. COUNCIL ON HOSPITAL DENTAL SERVICE. The duties of
1624 the Council shall be:

1625 a. To examine dental services in hospitals and in-patient
1626 care units other than hospitals and to issue, in the name
1627 of the American Dental Association, certificates of
1628 approval to those institutions having dental services
1629 which meet the basic standards established by the House
1630 of Delegates.

1631 b. To act on behalf of the Association in the inspection
1632 and improvement of hospital dental services.

CHAPTER XII • BUREAUS

Section 10. NAME (lines 1385-1390) amended by the addition of the following as subsection A and by the relettering of the former subsections A-E to B-F:

1633 A. Bureau of Audiovisual Service.

Section 30. DUTIES (lines 1405-1409) amended to read as follows:

1634 C. BUREAU OF LIBRARY AND INDEXING SERVICE.

1635 a. To maintain and develop the library services of the
1636 Association.

1637 b. To prepare and cause to be published an index to dental
1638 literature.

Section 30 (lines 1397-1426) further amended by the addition of the following as subsection A and by the relettering of the former subsections A-E to B-F:

1639 A. BUREAU OF AUDIOVISUAL SERVICE.

1640 a. To develop and maintain a film library and a program
1641 of audiovisual service for the Association.

1642 b. To foster the use and production of audiovisual mate-
1643 rials of interest to the dental profession.
