2019 NODA Honor Dentist: Dr. Kevin J. Collins

 2_{019} was my final year as Chairman of the NODA Honors & Awards Committee. I wish to thank Dr. Darrell Bourg, who originally asked me to chair this committee in 2013, as well as all of the past and present committee members. During my tenure as Chair, we have honored some of the most highly respected dentists in Louisiana with NODA's most prestigious award, Honor Dentist. Since 2013, that list Frank Martello. includes Drs. Randy Green, Robert Barsley, Kristi Soileau, Mark Chaney, and David Hildebrandt. The 2019 recipient is Dr. Kevin J. Collins. He will officially be presented with the award at the President's Banquet on March 13 at Metairie Country Club. Kevin is a 1987 graduate of the LSU School of Dentistry. He was born in Illinois, but arrived in New Orleans with his family in 1967. He graduated from Holy Cross High School and the University of New Orleans. Kevin was originally contemplating a career in medicine

to follow in the footsteps of his uncle and cousins, but college classmates and friends encouraged him to consider dentistry. Having experienced numerous dental challenges of his own during adolescence and young adulthood, he became astutely aware of the positive impacts that dentistry could have on a person's life. And so it was in his junior year at UNO that he made the commitment to become a dentist. Upon graduation from dental school, Dr. Collins became an Associate in the office of Dr. Patrick Hambrick. In 1990, he purchased the Metairie practice of Dr. Ronald Brandt where he continues to practice today. Dr. Collins considers both Drs. Hambrick and Brandt to have been influential mentors in his early years in dentistry and he reflects often upon some of their early counsel, much of which still resonates today about avoiding complacency in one's knowledge base and skills. He also described the influence of Dr. Guy Ribando, who encouraged Kevin to get involved and stay involved in organized dentistry.

Dr. Collins' participation in organized dentistry has been and continues to be exceptional. Like many recipients of the Honor Dentist, it all started by simply being asked by someone to get involved. The first committee upon which he participated was the NODA membership committee under the chairmanship of Dr. Vance Wascom. He

later chaired that committee from 1996 - 2000. He then joined the NODA Board of Directors and eventually became NODA's President in 2005. What fortune to be NODA's President during one of the greatest man-made disasters in our country's history. Kevin recalls the tumult that ensued and the challenges he faced in the aftermath of everything that disrupted NODA members' personal and professional lives. "That was a very difficult time for our organization, especially when we lost Mrs. Mona Whittington, who helped me a lot during my time as President."

After finishing his term as NODA President. Dr. Collins became the Chairman of New Orleans Dental Enterprises in 2006, a position he continues to hold today. He became an Alternate Director to the LDA in 2009 and eventually LDA Director for three terms from 2012 - 15. He represented the NODA component at the LDA House of Delegates from 2000 - 12 and 2016 - 19. In addition to tripartite membership, Dr. Collins is a member of the Crescent City New Orleans branch of the Seattle Study group, the American Association of Facial Esthetics, the Occlusion Design group, and the Gems Insider Circle Mastermind group. participated in the Louisiana's Mission of Mercy events in 2015 & 16.

2019 NODA Honor Dentist: Dr. Kevin J. Collins - Con't

Outside of dentistry, Kevin is in the St. Edward's Catholic Church Men's Club. He was honored with Fellowship in the American College of Dentists in 2017 and will be inducted into the International College of Dentists later this year. Dr. Collins extends gratitude to Mr. Andrew Hale, Mrs. Gina Brewer, and all former NODA employees, all of whom have assisted him in his various roles with NODA.

When asked how organized dentistry has helped shape Dr. Collins' career, he said it was "Without a doubt, the best thing he ever did to advance his success in dentistry." He added, "At times, many of us go through cycles where we question our skills, our knowledge, and our commitment. people with whom I surrounded myself by virtue of being involved helped me to re-focus and re-energize the passion for dentistry that I was losing. The personal and professional relationships you develop working when with colleagues towards a common goal, those relationships are rewarding and priceless to an extent that I cannot put into words or quantify in any measurable way what that really means to me."

Dr. Collins is concerned that younger dentists may not be getting the complete message of the importance of active participation in organized dentistry. Especially with some of the staggering student loans upon graduation, he worries that they will forego membership in an effort to save money in those early years. And once they get accus-

tomed to not belonging to the ADA, it will be that much more difficult to get them to join later. He says, "Dentists are either going to float together or sink together. I'd rather float." He adds, "There is so much free information for younger dentists to glean from those of us who have been there and tried that. I just wish they would give organized dentistry a chance and learn how we have to meet the professional challenges of the future as a collective body."

As for his concerns regarding dentistry's future, Dr. Collins noted the, at times, unfavorable influence of non-dental entities interfering in the doctor-patient relationship. He says, "If we wish to remain the primary directors of our patients' dental care, we're going to have to continue to fight for it. And if we don't do so, we'll have only ourselves to blame for what we lose."

Outside of dentistry, Dr. Collins occasionally golfs. He enjoys attending New Orleans Saints games (except when they're getting cheated by the refs) and Zephyrs/Baby Cakes baseball games.

When asked what receiving this award meant to him, Dr. Collins says he was shocked and admittedly emotional when he received the call. He said, "I never expected it or thought I would ever be considered. Most of all, I'm deeply humbled. I am an ordinary man and an ordinary dentist doing the best I can to help my patients, this Association, and the wonderful profession of dentist-

ry. To be mentioned alongside the men and women who have been previously honored with this award is remarkable. I'm grateful and mostly humbled." NODA members can call Dr. Collins at his Metairie office (504/733-0484) to offer your congratulations.






