The following amendments to the Bylaws of the American Dental Association were approved by the House of Delegates at the 1963 annual session.

CHAPTER I • MEMBERSHIP

Section 50A. Dues and Reinstatement (lines 192-193) amended to read:

1653 A. ACTIVE MEMBERS. The dues of active members shall be 1654 forty dollars (\$40.00) due on January 1 of each year.

CHAPTER II · CONSTITUENT SOCIETIES


Section 40B. REMOVAL FROM ONE JURISDICTION TO AN-OTHER (lines added after lines 277-283) amended by the addition of the following paragraph:

1655 A dentist who retires from active practice and establishes 1656 residence in an area outside of the jurisdiction of the con-1657 stituent society in which he holds membership shall be 1658 permitted to continue his membership in such constituent 1659 society for the period of his retirement.

CHAPTER VI • BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Section 10. Composition (lines 711-717) amended to read:

1660 Section 10. Composition: The Board of Trustees shall con-1661 sist of one (1) trustee from each of the thirteen (13) trustee 1662 districts. Such thirteen (13) trustees, the President-elect 1663 and the three Vice-presidents shall constitute the voting 1664 membership of the Board of Trustees. In addition, the 1665 President and the appointive officers of the Association, 1666 except as otherwise provided in these Bylaws, shall be 1667 ex officio members of the Board without the right to vote.



Section 90A. DUTIES (lines 799-801) amended to read:

1668 A. To provide for the purchase, sale, mortgage, mainte-1669 nance and supervision of the Central Office and all other 1670 property or offices owned or operated by this Association.

CHAPTER IX · COUNCILS

Section 110H. COUNCIL ON HOSPITAL DENTAL SERVICE (lines 1179-1188) amended to read:

- 1671 H. COUNCIL ON HOSPITAL DENTAL SERVICE. The duties of 1672 the Council shall be:
- 1673 a. To examine dental services in hospitals and patient care
- units other than hospitals and to issue, in the name of the
- 1675 American Dental Association, certificates of approval to
- 1676 those institutions having dental services which meet the
- 1677 basic standards or requirements established by the House
- 1678 of Delegates.
- 1679 b. To act on behalf of the Association in the inspection and
- 1680 improvement of dental services in hospitals and patient
- 1681 care units other than hospitals.
