2018 NODA Honor Dentist: Dr. David J. Hildebrandt

The New Orleans Dental Association Honors & Awards committee is pleased to announce the recipient of the 2018 Honor Dentist: Dr. David J. Hildebrandt. Dr. Hildebrandt will be presented with the award at the President's Banquet on March 8 at New Orleans Country Club. A 1984 graduate of the LSU School of Dentistry, David is the immediate Past President of the Louisiana Dental Association and was President of the New Orleans Dental Association in 2004.

When asked about his career path, Dr. Hildebrandt related that he was still contemplating a career choice by his junior year at Jesuit High School in New Orleans. He had narrowed it down to medicine versus dentistry. His childhood dentist, former NODA President, Dr. William "Bill" Schmidt, invited David to shadow at his office and effectively sealed the decision. David says Dr. Schmidt impressed upon him the value of having one's own office, the ability to chart a unique path that satisfied his personality and goals, establishing one's own work schedule, and the potential for lifelong relationships with colleagues and patients.

Dr. Hildebrandt recalls his family moved to New Orleans when he was in the 3rd grade, but only lived there one year before moving to Metairie. He lived one block from Lake Pontchartrain and recalls great memories of fishing for speckled trout every weekend. David met his future wife, Jeanne, at a Jesuit High School fair in 1977 and they were married in his junior year of dental school. Following graduation, David went into private practice in Slidell, where he continues today. David and Jeanne are faithful LSU football fans and travel to almost every home game and some road games annually. They also enjoy traveling across the world. An avid golfer, David hits the links at least once or twice weekly, weather permitting. His number one activity, however, is family time. The Hildebrandts have two sons, Christopher David (31) and Ryan Andrew (29).

While in dental school, Dr. Hildebrandt was a member of Delta Sigma Delta fraternity. Through that organization, he struck a friendship with Dr. Ray Unland. Following graduation from dental school, Dr. Unland prompted David to attend NODA functions and eventually to serve on the NODA Board. As most leaders do, he began as an at-large member on the Board of Governors. He enjoyed the camaraderie with fellow Board members, chaired many committees, and eventually held nearly every office of the Board, including the aforementioned office of President.

His commitment and volunteerism in dentistry and his community befit a recipient of the Honor Dentist award. He served as President of New Orleans Dental Enterprise from 1995-2003. He was a NODA delegate to the LDA House of Delegates from 1987-2012. He joined the LDA Board of Directors in 2013 and served as LDA President in 2017-18. He was also involved as Chairman for several committees of the New Orleans Dental Conference & LDA Annual Session, serving as General Chairman for the 2009 conference. He was President of Dental Lifeline Network from 2013-17. He was President of the Slidell Dental Study Association from 1989-90 and again from 1993-94. He was inducted as a Fellow in the American College of Dentists in 2016.

2018 NODA Honor Dentist: Dr. David J. Hildebrandt - Con't.

Dr. Hildebrandt served in the United States Army Reserve Dental Corps from 1985 - 1996. His community service is equally impressive to his dental volunteerism. He has been Chairman of the Good Samaritan Ministry since 2014. He was Scoutmaster of BSA Troop 348 from 1999-2006 and bestowed with the BSA Silver Beaver Award (the highest award given by a BSA council). He served as Cubmaster for Cub Scout Pack 437 from 1992-99. He served as President of Turtle Creek Homeowners Association for two separate terms. He received a Mayor's Certificate of Appreciation in 1989 from the City of Slidell and an Award of Achievement from the Foundation for the Medically Handicapped. He received St. Luke Catholic Church's "Good Samaritan of the Month" recognition in 1999 for providing unreimbursed dental care to several indigent families

When asked about people he considers mentors, Dr. Hildebrandt mentioned Dr. Schmidt as someone who remained a mentor until his passing in 2014. He also remarked about the influence of Dr. F. Harold Wirth (the first recipient of NODA's Honor Dentist). Dr. Wirth's mantra of maintaining a positive mental attitude ("How's your PMA?") resonates with David to this day. He also recalls Dr. Wirth's definition of success as being less about dollars and material possessions and more about how loved and respected you are by your patients. He said Dr. Wirth would say if patients are not bringing you


gifts of homemade goodies or sending you pictures of their kids and grandkids or bringing you fresh caught fish or just dropping by the office to say hello, then you haven't yet achieved success.

Dr. Hildebrant remarked that his involvement in organized dentistry has shaped his dental career daily. He said "By being involved, I learned from the best and brightest dentists in our area. Organized dentistry helped my leadership skills, yielded insightful guidance on running a dental office, and provided invaluable knowledge gained via the camaraderie of fellow dentists." In spite of the many headwinds dentistry is facing today, he still views the profession optimistically. He related that new technology has completely changed the manner in which he performs

many procedures, yielding greater efficiency and quality.

Dr. Hildebrandt's message to the newest generation of dentists is to get and stay involved with organized dentistry because of the support and valuable resources that it can provide to those who choose to take advantage of it. Colleagues in dentistry remain open to helping each other so that if you're having a problem with any aspect of dental practice, be it clinical or administrative, there's most likely someone else who has effectively navigated the same challenge.

Finally, Dr. Hildebrandt expressed his immense gratitude for being selected by his peers for NODA's most prestigious award and hopes to see as many of his friends as possible at the President's Banquet in March.

The NODA Honors & Awards committee is proud to announce the recipient of the 2018 Victor B. Marquer Award is Mrs. Marilyn Brandt. The Marquer award is bestowed periodically in recognition of an individual's distinguished and dedicated service to the New Orleans Dental Association. The award was last conferred in 2014 and includes recipients such as Mr. Charles Brennan (1990), Mrs. Normalee Ward (1995), Mr. Tony Abadie (1998), Mrs. Marie Bordenave (2000), Mr. Lloyd Brandt, Sr. (2001), and the current NODA Executive Director, Mr. Andrew Hale (2014), among others. This year's recipient, Mrs. Brandt, has been a faithful and vital member of the conference team that plans and organizes our annual dental convention.

Mrs. Brandt is a 1956 graduate of Ursuline Academy. She completed Mercy Nursing School in 1959 and was a nurse at Mercy Hospital for 20 years. In 2000, NODA's Conference Executive Secretary, Mrs. Normalee Ward, requested that Marilyn assist with the invitations to the Conference's Welcome Reception because, according to Marilyn, "Norma liked my handwriting." From that point onward, Mrs. Brandt became an integral part of Conference preparation, including printing and organizing the registration, speaker, and speaker host and room monitor packets. To this day, she can be found at every Conference in the speaker and speaker host check-in room. When asked what she enjoys the most about working with our conference, Marilyn responded, "It's the people. I enjoy seeing everyone that I have met over the years and I enjoy working with the members of the conference committee to see that everything runs as smoothly as possible."

Mrs. Brandt is a true leader, having served as President of the Mercy Nurses Alumnae, President of St. Angela Merici Mothers' Club, President of City Park Woman's Tennis Club, President of CPA Wives Club of New Orleans, and Queen Mother of the Chattyats Red Hat Association. Among many hobbies are cooking, gardening, sewing, and pearl stringing. She received a certification for jewelry in 1983 from Delgado University. Her interest in jewelry making dates back to the 1960's when Dr. Melville Smith asked Marilvn's father-in-law, Mr. Lloyd Brandt, Sr., a German jeweler, to design a dental key for NODA to bestow to the outgoing President each year in recognition of services to the organization. The original key was worn as a watch fab on a chain that hung from a gentleman's pants pocket. When this went out of style, the

organization requested that it be changed to a tie tack to be worn on the lapel of a suit, as the key pin remains today.

While in school for jewelry, Mrs. Brandt met Mr. Sal Michon, who at the time was working for a dental supply company. When that company closed, he opened Michon Jewelers, learned more about jewelry making from Mr. Brandt, and eventually became the provider for the NODA key pin to this day. Mrs. Brandt has a copy of the original Brandt's Jewelry store bill from 1970 when she delivered the first NODA key on behalf of Mr. Brandt, himself a recipient of the Victor B. Marquer award in 2001.

Mrs. Brandt has been married to Dr. Lloyd Brandt, Jr. for 58 years (59 years in August). They have four daughters: Karen Brandt (56), Kim Brandt Burr (55), Kathryn Berrigan (54), and Karol Brandt (52). The Brandts have four grandchildren and five great grandchildren. When notified that she will be the 2018 honoree, she remarked, "I am humbled to receive this award that my father-in-law received so many years ago. I know that there is a special angel named Normalee who brought me into this dental family and she is who inspired me to receive it." On behalf of the members of the New Orleans and Louisiana Dental Associations, the Honors and Awards committee expresses its appreciation for Mrs. deepest Brandt's dedication and service to our organizations and the profession of dentistry and congratulates her on being the recipient of the Victor B. (504/834-6449) if you can volunteer.






