## **NODA Welcomes a New Leader**



## **Money Sense**

How Volatility Affects Us as People

Stock market turbulence may influence your decision- making in helpful or harmful ways. These ideas from Merrill Lynch Wealth Management can help you understand your reactions and avoid actions motivated by fear.
