ADA Foundation Dr. David Whiston Leadership Award Nomination Period Open

Nomination deadline: Friday, June 17, 2016

Chicago, May 31, 2016 – The ADA Foundation is seeking nominations for its Dr. David Whiston Leadership Awards, which recognize promising dentists who have shown the potential for leadership in efforts to improve the oral health of the public. The nomination deadline has been extended to June 17, 2016.

The ADA Foundation provides two \$5,000 awards each year—The Dr. David Whiston Leadership Award and the Henry Schein Cares Dr. David Whiston Leadership Award—designed to cover the costs associated with attending a leadership training program offered by the American Management Association.
