Medicare---Opt in or Opt Out?

All dentists treating Medicare patients will need to make this decision before June 1, 2016, to avoid putting a Medicare patient at risk of not receiving coverage for prescriptions from dental providers.

The ADA News reports the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services has extended the deadline for dentists to either enroll as a Medicare Part D "ordering/referring provider" or opt out of the program. The deadline is now February 1, 2017, but CMS "encourages health care providers to submit their Medicare enrollment applications before August 1st." The agency repeatedly postponed enforcement of the law at the request of the American Dental Association and other provider groups as they sought to inform their membership of enrollment requirement.

However, there will be a 90-day grace period before the first denial. To be exact, the first time a provider who has not enrolled or opted out writes a prescription for a patient with a Medicare Part D drug plan, the plan will give the patient a provisional supply of the drug and a letter saying that due to the provider's Medicare enrollment status the drug will not be covered after the first three months. According to CMS, the Part D plan must also make reasonable efforts to notify the provider of the situation.

What steps should you take? To help your Medicare Patients, you need to enroll in Medicare either to bill fully or for the limited purpose of prescribing Part D drugs. There are no fees to

complete the process. You can do so electronically or on paper:

- Electronic Process-----go.cms.gov/pecos

- Paper Process-----go.cms.gov/cms855o

It is important to note that if a provider officially opts out of Medicare, his or her patients who are on Medicare will still receive their Part D drug benefits for the prescription the provider writes. However, the dentist will not be eligible to receive payments from a Medicare Advantage plan. Again, a provider must choose either to enroll or opt out. Only by doing neither does a provider put a Medicare patient at risk of not receiving coverage for prescriptions.

These new CMS rules will enable federal officials to better combat fraud and abuse in the Part D program through verification of provider's credentials via the Medicare enrollment process.

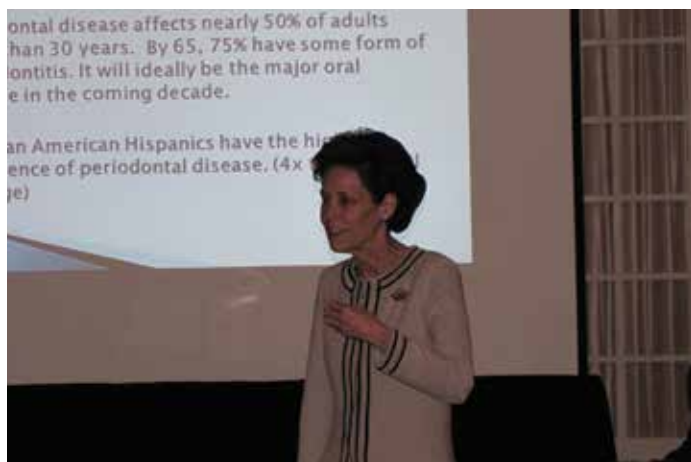
