

### **In Defense of Our Industry – Join LADPAC Now!**

Did you know that if Dentistry were to lose its Louisiana State tax exemption, a practice with an annual gross of \$750,000 could pay \$30,000 in taxes annually? Currently, 32 states have eliminated the exemption. Louisiana could be next unless we remain vigilant and work closely with LADPAC and the Louisiana Legislature.

The Louisiana Dental Political Action Committee (LAD-PAC) is a voluntary, non-profit, committee unaffiliated with any political party. Its purpose is to assist dentists in organizing for more effective political action; to encourage dentists to be more active in governmental affairs; and to collaborate with member Dentists to build and sustain relationships with their designated elected officials.

The primary role of LAD-PAC is to play defense and stay ahead of the political curve. At the State level, LADPAC is doing so on the issue of mid-level providers. On the Parish / local level, when Lafayette Parish declared that renewal tax issues were not covered by the state tax exemption, LADPAC joined in the fight.

Of course to maintain our defensive posture, it takes paying attention to the Legislature generally and to the political pre-dispositions of individual Legislators. To do so, requires support and financial participation of LADPAC by member Dentists. LADPAC is funded primarily in two ways: 1) donations from members by including dues as a voluntary item on your annual dues statements, making a credit card payment, or mailing a check to the LDA at any time; and 2) proceeds from the LDA's "Split the Pot Raffle" benefit.

The LADPAC funds are then used to make contributions to designated, "go-to" Legislators who have been friends of our industry, as well as to partially cover Dentists' Day at the Legislature.

"As I have said many times, it is very important that we keep in contact with our legislators. They appreciate hearing from you, their constituents, so do your best to call, write, e-mail, and thank them for listening to our concerns about legislation that affects the practice of dentistry," said Dr. David Kestel, Chairman of LADPAC.




