
Hello Everyone,



Martine Domangue, George Syll Jr, (Am- ber), Stephanie Syll, Elizabeth Cameron Sweeting, John "Jack" Wegmann, William Wegmann, great-grandson Ayden Syll, and caregiver Josh Batchelor.

Born January 20, 1920 the son of John X. Wegmann and Sophie Bonhage Wegmann, he grew up in a large catholic family with 10 brothers. He was predeceased by his brothers George J., August A., John X. Jr., Charles H., Fr. Anthony J., Joseph A., Leo F., Msgr. Raymond A., Edward F., and William J. Wegmann. He married, raised his family, and lived his entire life in the
