2021 NODA Honor Dentist: Claudia Cavallino, D.D.S.

The New Orleans Dental Association’s Honors & Awards committee is pleased to announce the recipient of the 2021 Honor Dentist: Dr. Claudia Cavallino. Dr. Cavallino will be presented with this award at the President’s Banquet on March 19th at the Southern Yacht Club. A 2002 graduate of the LSU School of Dentistry, Claudia is a past Chairman of the New Orleans Dental Conference/LDA Annual Session and past Co-Chair of Children’s Dental Health month.

When asked about her career path, Dr. Cavallino related that she had decided on her career choice after temping in her Dad’s dental office. “I grew up working in my father’s practice during my teenage years and never really thought that I had an affinity for the sciences or health care. That all changed when I ended up temping in my dad’s office one day when he had an employee out sick. I had not worked in the clinical side of dentistry since before college. It was a completely different

experience and it piqued my interest. So, even though I already had my bachelor’s degree, I enrolled at UNO to take some basic science courses. The rest is history.”

Following graduation from dental school, Dr. Cavallino first got involved in organized dentistry after receiving a call from Dr. Glenn Dubroc. Claudia recalls, “The year after Katrina, I received a phone call from Dr. Glenn Dubroc asking me if I would be interested in becoming involved with the New Orleans Dental Conference committee. I was only 2 years out of residency with very little experience in organized dentistry, so I thought it would be a good challenge to help “resurrect” the NODC and a worthwhile cause. Claudia joined the Conference committee in 2007 and after serving on multiple committees became Chairman in 2012. She continued on the Conference committee thru 2017.

The ADA's Third-Party Payer Concierge service was resumed on January 4th to help member dentists with dental insurance concerns involving third-party payers, according to ADA News. "Even though many dentists' issues come down to contractual obligations, the ADA can provide education on the nuances of doing business with dental insurance companies and how to empower themselves to

make decisions that are best for their patients and their practices," said Mark Johnston, D.D.S., chair of the Dental Benefit Information Subcommittee of the ADA Council on Dental Benefit Programs. The 2021 House of Delegates passed a resolution to restart the service after a one-year hiatus and added a five-year evaluation period. More information is available at ADA.org/dentalinsurance.

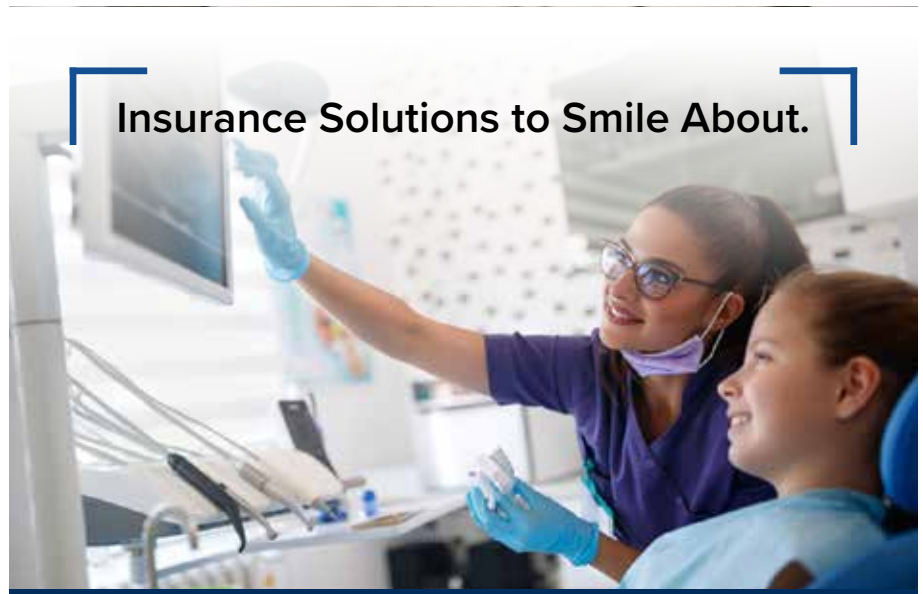

Financial Strategies to Prepare for the Unexpected

If COVID-19 or Hurricane Ida impacted your finances, you're far from alone. In fact, the pandemic delivered the highest unemployment rate since the Great Depression, leading to significant job loss, and lost or reduced income, for thousands of people. Ida is estimated to have had an economic impact of \$95 billion, including factors such as damaged homes and vehicles, and work disruption. Unfortunately, health or natural disasters are just two examples of unexpected events that can derail a financial plan. Major home repairs, medical expenses, legal bills, a surprise pregnancy, a death in the family or unexpected elder care needs — among other events — can all impact your finances while shifting your goals and priorities. The good news is that you can create safeguards to help get through such situations and limit financial disruption, so you can get back on track faster to reaching your goals.

Define for Needs, Wants and Wishes

In general, it can be helpful to create or revisit your financial plan. This typically involves defining your goals, timelines and steps for reaching those targets. In addition, this step usually includes assessing where you are now in terms of that plan, what's changed and what adjustments you may need to make to get where you want to be. For instance, as part of the plan, you might break expenses into needs, wants and wishes. You could then create a budget that would cover

only your needs and another budget that adds in costs for your wants and wishes. If something unexpected occurs, this approach may allow you to fall back on that needs-only budget or look at the full budget to

easily see what you could remove or adjust to fit your current situation. Planning to save can be challenging, especially for dentists early in their

career. Having new found income prompts many to buy cars, homes, and take vacations that were previously unattainable. It is imperative to consider saving as early as possible due to compounding. Compounding is earning interest on interest which is far more powerful than simple interest. For example, earning 5% annually on \$1000 will give you \$1005 at the end of the year. With simple interest, this would add only \$5 per year. Let's say you put that money away earning interest for 10 years. In 10 years under simple interest, you would get \$5 per year x 10 years which equals \$50. With compounding interest, this interest will remain in the account and earn interest on it as well. This would be $\$1000 \times (1.05)^{10}$ which equals \$628.89 earned on interest. The power of compounding is something to consider taking advantage of as soon as possible.

Assess Your Savings

Another step may be to look at your savings and investments. For many people, it's helpful to prioritize building an emergency savings fund that lets you quickly access cash in case of an unexpected setback. You could keep the fund in a savings, money market account or short-term CDs. You could also consider a home equity line of credit. Experts typically suggest having enough funds to cover three months of expenses for dual-income households and six months for single-income households. Consid-

er sacrificing in the short term to put your finances at ease and not rely on earning potential going forward to fill in the gaps. In general, reacting rashly in the face of a financial crisis may not be helpful. For instance, making significant changes to investments or retirement accounts could cause long-term damage that may be harder to recover from than the initial problem.

Evaluate Benefits and Insurance

For many dentists, employee benefits are not available. However, insurance could add another safety net. Homeowners insurance may help mitigate losses in the face of natural disasters. Likewise, if you experience the death of a spouse or income earner, life insurance may be able to provide funds for funeral expenses, costs of daily living, debt payments and more. Trusts may also help safeguard your financial interests in the event of your own untimely death. They may be useful if you want to maintain some control over distribution of assets when you're gone. For instance, if your heirs are too young to handle a large inheritance or you want to support a special needs child, you might create a trust that distributes funds at a specific age or for specific needs.

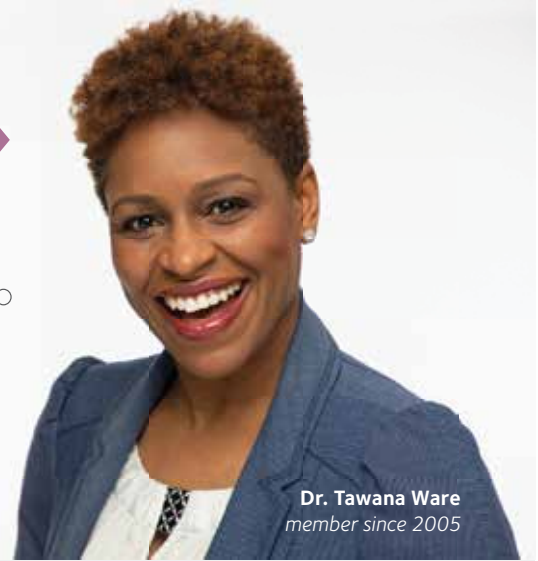
