Dr. Geist Named Outstanding Alumnus



Dr. Eric Geist, a graduate of the doctoral and oral surgery programs at the LSU School of Dentistry

(LSUSD), has been selected outstanding alumnus for 2011. He will receive the award during the school's Alumni Day on September 23rd The announcement was made by Dr. Henry Gremillion, dean of LSUSD. "For decades, Dr. Geist has consistently reached out to serve his profession and his community, both throughout nationally and Louisiana," Dr. Gremillion said. "He gives wholeheartedly himself as a teacher, leader and practitioner. In the process, he exemplifies the finest qualities of dentistry and medicine."

Dr. Geist, a native of Houma, received his DDS from LSUSD in 1979. One year later he completed his internship at LSU Medical Center in Shreveport, followed by the completion of his residency at LSU Medical Center in New Orleans in 1984. Two years later he became a diplomate of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery. Since that time he has been in private practice in Monroe. He is an associate professor at the University of Louisiana in Monroe and assistant clinical professor in the Department of Surgery at LSU Medical Center in Shreveport.

Leadership Roles

Since 1989, Dr. Geist has served in 22 different leadership positions in the American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery (AAOMS) and received awards for fundraising and achievement. He has been integral to the leadership of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, including service as president, vice-president and member of the board of directors. In 2002, he was honored with their Examination Committee Award.

The LSU Tiger Athletic Foundation has recognized him for outstanding service. Since 1990, he has served in various leadership roles in the American Dental Association, which awarded him its "Grassroots Award for Outstanding Service" in 1999. He has been equally active in professional

organizations in Louisiana, including the Louisiana Dental Association, Northeast Louisiana Dental Association and the Louisiana Society of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery.

Dr. Geist has co-authored or edited 16 peer-reviewed publications. His research interests include the effects of diet, tobacco and alcohol on dental health.



Graduate Honored for Community Service

Raj Diwan, D.D.S., a 2011 graduate of the LSU School of Dentistry and currently a resident in the General Practice Residency, is one of four students nationally to receive the first-ever Student Leadership Servant Award presented by The Academy of Dentistry International (ADI). The award includes a \$500 stipend. It was presented by Dr. Don Brown, president of the ADI Foundation President.

The purpose of the award is to recognize senior dental students who have excelled in volunteerism and student leadership. As a dental student, Dr. Diwan founded the student service organization called "Making Impressions." He recruited a leadership team and network of dental students and

hygienists that helped more than 1,000 people through oral health screenings, provision of dental supplies, and one-on-one education. The student volunteers helped the homeless population in the inner city, along with suburban parents, unwed mothers and HIV/AIDS patients living in a hospice.

"Our purpose was to connect with the neglected communities of our state," Dr. Diwan said. "We wanted to promote volunteerism through the dental school with the hope of continuing the concept of service as practitioners."

The award was initiated by Dr. T. Bob Davis, USA Section Board Secretary and South Central Regent. The three other recipients are recent graduates of The University of Texas School of Dentistry at Houston, the Dental School at the University of Texas Health Science Center in San Antonio and Texas A&M Health Science Center Baylor College of Dentistry.


