





American Dental Association Supports Tobacco-Free School Laws -

At its annual governance meeting, the American Dental Association (ADA) House of Delegates recently adopted a resolution supporting tobacco-free school laws and policies to prevent tobacco use and addiction in children.

According to the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), a tobacco-free school can help prevent and reduce tobacco use in youth and help them avoid tobacco-related diseases such as cancer and heart disease.

ADA delegates voted to support laws or policies that incorporate the "Guidelines for School Health **Programs** to Tobacco Use Prevention and Addiction" developed by the CDC in collaboration with tobacco-use prevention experts across the country. The guidelines include prevention tobacco-use education in kindergarten through and support 12th grade cessation efforts tobacco-use among students and school staff.

The ADA encourages its members and state dental societies to collaborate with students, parents, school officials and members of their communities to establish tobacco-free schools.

Dr. Sartin was the son of Admiral Lea Bennett Sartin, M.D., USN, and Cecile Menville Sartin, of Houma, Louisiana. Because his father was a navy physician, young John moved all over the country and the world, receiving his education at a wide variety of schools. He served as a pharmacist's mate in the United States Navy during World War II. Before World War II, he studied pre-medicine at Tulane University, but left the program and joined the United States Navy after his father was taken prisoner by the Japanese at the very start of the war.

After the war, he studied dentistry at Loyola University, during which time on a blind date he met the love of his life. Norris Mary Murphy (Sartin). They were married June 2, 1948, and they enjoyed a beautiful marriage of 61 years. They were blessed with three children: John Menville (Donnette) Sartin, Jr. (deceased), Dr. Barry (Carol) Sartin, and Glen (Thomas) Sartin Becker. John and Norris eventually settled in the Lakeview section of New Orleans, living in the same home from 1950 through August 29, 2005, when Hurricane Katrina flooded their home. necessitating their move Metairie. During his Lakeview years, he was a parishioner of St. Pius X Church, where for many vears he served as an usher and eucharistic minister.

He also established his dental practice in Lakeview. While gaining a reputation as a skilled and meticulous professional, he quietly gave of his talents by performing free dental work for members of the clergy and religious, as well as for countless patients of limited means. 
