Oklahoma Dentist Installed as American Dental Association Trustee

CHICAGO, Nov. 9, 2015 – Raymond A. Cohlmiya, D.D.S., an Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, general dentist and Dean of the University of Oklahoma College of Dentistry, was recently installed as a trustee of the American Dental Association (ADA). Dr. Cohlmiya's installation took place in Washington, D.C. at the ADA's 156th Annual Meeting.

Dr. Cohlmiya will serve on the ADA Board of Trustees as the trustee from the Twelfth District, which encompasses Arkansas, Kansas, Louisiana and Oklahoma. The ADA Board of Trustees formulates and reviews policies and programs and makes recommendations to the members of the ADA's governing body, the House of Delegates. As a member of the ADA Board of Trustees, Dr. Cohlmiya will play a major role in the organization's objective of being America's leading advocate for oral health.

In addition to his role as Dean, Dr. Cohlmiya is also an associate clinical professor and instructor at the University of Oklahoma College of Dentistry. His previous roles at the ADA include positions on the Council on Membership, Committee on Strategic Planning and Committee on the New Dentist. He is past-president of both the Oklahoma Dental Association and the Oklahoma County Dental Society, and for thirteen years served as editor of the Oklahoma Dental Association Journal.

Dr. Cohlmiya earned his dental degree from the University of Oklahoma College of Dentistry. He and his wife, Sherry, reside in northwest Oklahoma City and have three children, Derek, Brandon and Joshua.
