at large. In late November, the MDA Foundation Board of Directors awarded 12 scholarships totaling \$31,000 to an amazing group of candidates from the largest field of applicants in years. Thanks to our donors' generosity, we were able to more than double the value of the scholarships awarded! You'll also have a chance to meet some of the scholarship recipients during the MDA Foundation's Sparkling Smiles Celebration, Wednesday April 17, from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. at the East Lansing Marriott Hotel. This special event recognizes and thanks MDA Foundation donors, and acknowledges grant and scholarship recipients. The MDA Foundation's biggest effort to provide access to care will occur in June, when we hold the first Mission of Mercy of the 2020s at the Dort Financial Center in Flint. During the two days of treatment offered at the MOM, we hope to provide essential dental care to as many as 2,000 people. Volunteers will set up the dental clinic on Thursday, June 13. Patients will begin lining up for care that evening. Anyone in line from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m., June 14 and 15 will undergo dental triage to determine their most urgent need and receive appropriate treatment. Participants can return to the line to receive further care if they wish to do so.

Please volunteer your time and skills to deliver care to those in need. Ask your dental team to volunteer, too. There are plenty of roles for family members as well, from helping set up or tear down to being patient escorts, line monitors, and much more. Sign up for the days and hours that fit your schedule. She recognized that tomorrow's dentists represent the long-term future of organized dentistry, and that these young dentists hail from different demographic groups than their predecessors.
